ABSENT:

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Alderman Schultz moved for the approval of the Agenda, amended to add Resolution 2017-5, seconded by Alderman Paro. Motion carried unanimously

INVOICES OVER \$500: Alderman Schultz moved to pay invoices 1 through 8 in the amount of \$15,634.62 for September 23, 2016, seconded by Alderman Jordan. Motion carried unanimously.

PRESENTATION OF THE UNAPPROVED MINUTES: Alderman Schultz moved for approval of the September 7, 2017, Minutes of the Board of Alderman Meeting, seconded by Alderman Merz. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING: Establishing Ad Valorem Tax Rate for the Year 2017

Alderman Schultz made a motion to open up the Public Hearing to the public, on this subject only, seconded by Alderman Merz. Motion carried unanimously.

At this time, Alderwoman Dailes entered the meeting.

Mayor Doerr asked if anyone wished to address the Board on this or any other issue. Hearing none, Alderman Schultz moved to bring the meeting back to the Board, seconded by Alderman Merz. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

BILL NO. 2489 - INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN SCHULTZ

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL RATE OF *AD VALOREM* TAX LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2017 FOR DEBT SERVICE AND GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI.

Alderman Schultz read the Bill for the first time and moved for approval of the first reading of Bill No. 2489 and to go on to the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Jordan. Motion passed unanimously. Alderman Schultz then read Bill No. 2489 for a second time and thereafter made a motion that the Bill be approved by the Board of Alderman for enactment as an Ordinance, seconded by Alderman Jordan. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon the roll being called the votes were cast as follows: Alderman Schultz, yes; Alderwoman Dailes, yes; Alderman Jordan, yes; Alderman Merz, yes; Alderman Herl, yes; Alderman Fields, yes; and Alderman Paro, yes.

The majority of the members elected to the Board of Aldermen having voted for passage of Bill No. 2489, the Bill was passed by the Board and will become Ordinance No. 2405 when and if signed by the Mayor.

RESOLUTION 2017-5- INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PARO
