PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT-JIMMY KIRINCICH

- On Saturday, November 5, the maintenance staff noticed the indoor pool pump was making a loud noise as if one of the bearing was going out in the motor and a seal was leaking. On Monday, November 7 Jim and I disconnected one of the motors from the outdoor pool and swapped it out with the broken motor from the indoor causing no interruptions to the indoor pool schedule. Luckily, we had one motor that runs the outdoor pool that was an exact match. We will need to send the indoor pool pump off to be repaired before summer operations.
- In 2021, the City received a Community Development Block Grant for pool repairs for \$30,000. We are going to be replacing all the pool plumbing and valves in the pump room for both the indoor/outdoor pools. I created an RFP for this work and the attorney approved it. The RFP is due on Tuesday, December 13th. The bid is posted on the Countian, \$t. Louis County Hub, and our website. There is a bid opening meeting on December 13th at noon at City Hall. I will present the bids at the December 15th BOA meeting and provide a recommendation to the board of the selected contractor.
- The brochure was sent to the printer and should be in resident's mailboxes within the next week. Registration dates for winter programs are December 12 for Residents and January 3 for non-residents.

- During the month of November, the Recreation Center participated in the Feed the Masses event where over 20 Recreation centers compete to see who can raise the most canned goods. This year we raised 339 items. Those items will be dropped off Grace New Covenant Food Pantry on Friday.
- Coco Santa will be coming to the Recreation Center on Saturday, December 17th from 2-4pm. This is a free event for everyone. Bring the kids out and take a picture with Santa. There will be toys available for each child while supplies last. We are taking toy donations for this event. Donations can be dropped off at City Hall or the Recreation Center.
- On November 30th our maintenance staff noticed over 35 black crappie dumped in pruett park. I contacted the Missouri Department of Conservation and they deemed it wonton waste of natural resources. They documented the incident in case there is another incident in the future. Unfortunately, we have no suspect or evidence from the individual that dumped the fish. The fish were cleaned up by the maintenance staff and discarded.
- I provided you a full report on the van accident that happened on October 27th in email yesterday. We are still waiting on a quote to see how much it is going to cost to fix and how long it will take to get parts in for the bus. I will provide another update once I get more information. I received a quote as an option to replace the bus. That quote was roughly \$75,000 to purchase a smaller vehicle that can hold the same amount of passengers that we are currently transporting in the bus. The parks department currently has four operating pickup trucks, one ranger car, and one senior bus. Three of the pickup trucks are older than 2010. We have one broken bus that is on the front parking lot.
- Gymnasium Roof Renovation. I met with Steve the Site Manager and John the project manager from CRallo. They will be the two main individuals in charge of our project. They plan to start prep work in January to prepare for demolition. In February, demolition will start on the gymnasium roof. The steel trusses and decking are scheduled to be delivered on March 1st. At the point, Crallo will be able to start rebuilding the roof. I will provide a project schedule once I receive that from CRallo.
- Metro bus stop at the corner of Bellefontaine and Jennings station road was hit by car.
 The bus station pole and trashcan both received damage. This is a bus stop that the parks department maintains the trashcans. I reported the accident to Metro and that will be replacing both shortly.
- The men's sauna heater broke back towards the end of July. I was able to put money in the budget for this item. Our breakers are currently labeled for 208v 3 phase breaker. So a 3 phase heater was ordered. It took several weeks to receive the sauna unit. An electrician came out to install the unit this morning and someone rewired the breaker to be 240v 1 phase so the unit would not work. I contacted that company and they are

- going to swap the units out with the correct one. I am hoping to have the correct heater by the end of December.
- Do we have any update on the vacant positions that were not included in the recent pay scale adjustments? Since ordinance 2401 was repealed with this latest pay ordinance? I still need a pay scale for the office supervisor position and recreation supervisor position before I can hire an office supervisor. I would like to have an office supervisor hired asap so that I can be freed up from the front desk to meet with contractors as we get busy with renovations over the next few months. I am hoping the board can include an amendment to Bill 2655 to include all the vacant positions in the city that are currently budgeted for.
- Weight Room Renovation. Part of the grant that I received from the St. Louis Municipal Park Grant commission in October 2022 went to renovating the weight room. I am requesting to use the website sourcewell that provides state bid pricing on items. I would be able to get this project completed at state bid cost or I can go out for RFP? wanted to check with what the BOA preferred before moving forward.

TREASURER'S REPORT- RICK ROGNAN

EXCUSED ABSENT-NO REPORT CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT -DOROTHY WHITE COLEMAN

 Follow up on question Alderman Alease Dailes raised at last meeting regarding City of Winchester vs Charter Communications. If you recall this is a case I reported on in March of 2021. At that time, the City of Winchester had sued Charter Communication in a class action lawsuit on behalf of a number of municipalities. The allegations in the lawsuit was that Charter was to pay a license tax on its gross receipts derived from fees for services connected to its operations and Charter had not been paying those taxes. At the trail level, the municipalities won and in the judge's order, it listed the amount of money each municipality would be entitled to receive if the lawsuit was ultimately upheld in favor of the municipalities. The total award was thirty-nine million dollar and the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors is slated to receive \$198,495.00. I was under the impression that there had been some activity on the lawsuit, however as I had reported then it typically takes 2 years for these cases to go through court and Charter is appealing all the way up. As far as it can. I did check and the last pleading filed was a motion to transfer the case to the Supreme Court of Missouri. Charter lost at the court of appeals but it is now asking the Supreme Court to take the case up. So there has not been a ruling on the application to transfer the case so until the case is completed decided and the Supreme Court denies the application or Charter decides not to appeal anymore the Cities will not get any money because the lawsuit is not final. Given the way Charter is fighting this they may even seek a writ of certiorari to the United States Supreme Court. So, it's going to be awhile before the city or any city receives any money as a result of this lawsuit. So, I just wanted to update everybody on that. You still got some time to go.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. BILL #2658-AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI RELATING TO A POINT SYSTEM EVALUATION IN SUSPENDING OR REVOKING LIQUOR LICENSES (INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DINAH TATMAN)-

Alderman Dinah Tatman stated just wanted to read the Bill and have a discussion and not to vote on unless the board feels comfortable voting on it. Alderman Dinah Tatman motion for the first read. Mayor called for a second-Motion dies for a lack of a second.

DISCUSSION:

B. BILL # 2659-AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS RELATING TO SECTION 3-8 CERTAIN ACTS PROHIBITED ON PREMISES LICENSED TO SELL AT RETAIL INTOXICATING LIQUOR, WINE OR BEER AND SECTION 3-25 QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS. (INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DINAH TATMAN)

- Alderman Dinah Tatman stated just wanted to read the Bill and have a discussion and not to vote on unless the board feels comfortable voting on it. Alderman Tatman stated both should have just been on agenda for discussion.
- Alderman Alicia Smith states Bill #2659 states business should not be allowed to post advertisement of what they are selling, then how do they sale their liquor. - Attorney Dorothy White Coleman states this is part of your code already and the language states prohibited.
- Alderman Dinah Tatman states but in two things, one is the point system all of our liquor stores are out of compliance. We should get an inventory of their stock and we do not get that. Points will be taken away if not in compliance with the ordinance. I still advocate for our citizens safety over money.
- Alderman Alicia Smith states we already have an ordinance that only allows so many liquor licenses.-Alderman Dinah Tatman states she was not trying to prohibit liquor licenses but put something in place that will hold the ones that have liquor licenses to comply by our ordinance already in place.
- Alderman Alease Dailes asked a question pertaining to Bill #2658 to the City Attorney. If there are issues after issues with (Family Dollar, Gas Station) can we pull their liquor license at any time.
- Attorney Dorothy White Coleman stated no. There has to be some kind of due process somewhere, and this Ordinance does indeed, as Alderman Tatman builds in some safe guards to protect not just the city the holder of the license as well. If you look at the purpose clause, it specifically states "that the intent of the point system is to provide the board of alderperson with a non-arbitrary means to evaluate incidents occurring on premises for which a license to sale intoxicating liquor has been issued and to guide the board of alderperson in suspending or revoking a liquor license". This makes sure that there is a process in place so you don't get sued by someone by someone arguing that you been arbitrary in revoking are suspending their license. There is a procedure set forth on page 4 under section 4 that specifically says there has to be an incident report by the city police and then the board will look at that report and determine if there is probably cause to believe that the licensee has indeed committed a violation. If that is the case and the board decides based on the number of violations that it wants to revoke or suspend their license then that the holder of the license will get a hearing at that point and time. It just provides a system to guide the board and hopefully keep the city out of lawsuits. People who are claiming you are not treating them fairly.
- Alderman Peg Warnusz concerned about ordinances getting lost like a lot of other things. Who will have the responsibility of bringing the report to the board? In addition, to make sure it is thoroughly done.
- Attorney White Coleman stated Alderman Warnusz point is well taken. This is something the license collector handles. Because the board determines whether there is probably cause to believe that a violation has occurred, however there has to be followups to the licensee at that point and the person in the best position would be the license collector.

- Alderman James Thomas, Sr. states he thinks we are missing elements right now that are not being taken care of. Putting points on it is not going to do anything else, if they are not turning in what they are supposed to be turning in. That issue should be put back on the collector to get those reports. If he is putting those on the reports in my opinion, we do not need a point system because we will already have the evidence there. Because they have not done it. The other point I want to make, if we were to pass this tonight and people came for their liquor license in 26 days they would not be happy. We can hold them accountable through what we have in place now, and that is the collector's job.
- Alderman Dinah Tatman stated this is just a discussion.

MAYOR'S REPORT

- Mayor went to court yesterday; four of our prior alderpersons filed a lawsuit against the city and myself for not paying them. Two of them had a court date yesterday (Miranda Avant Elliott and Theresa Reed). Miranda informed the Judge she was representing herself and Theresa. Judge advised her she could represent herself but no one else.
- Case dismissed without prejudice
- Judge wants all four to appear at one time, not one here and one there.
- Intent there Carroll will represent Barbara West and the Judge will inform him of the same thing.

- -Reached out to RGSD to use gymnasium again for April 15 2023, or April 29th, 2023 (tentatively).

Additional sureties on such bond may be required by the board of aldermen at any time during the life of such license, if, in its discretion, it deems the surety of the bond to be insufficient or impaired, and such bond shall provide that the adding of additional sureties thereto, with or without notice to the existing sureties, shall in no way impair the liability of the sureties.

(b) Such bond may be sued on in the name of the city for the collection of any taxes, penalties, fines or license fees, and in the name of the city for the use and benefit of any person damaged by the breach of any of the other conditions of such bond or this article.

The indoor and outdoor pools currently still operate with the original cast iron valves and piping. Several of these valves have outlived their life expectancy and are needing to be replaced. The City of Bellefontaine is looking to replace the current piping and valves for both the indoor and outdoor pools. AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2196 AND OTHER ORDINANCES DEFINING THE WARD BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS AND FURTHER ESTABLISHING NEW WARD BOUNDARIES FOR ALL FOUR WARDS IN SAID CITY AND CONTAINING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section One.

As of the effective date hereinafter specified, Ordinance No. 2196 of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors approved the 6th day of October, 2010, as well as other prior ordinances defining the ward boundaries of said City are hereby repealed.

Section Two.

Definitions – "City Limits Line" "Boundary", as used with respect to boundary lines for any ward referenced herein or in the exhibits incorporated herein, shall mean a corporate limit line of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Missouri.

Definition – "Census Tract" "Census Block" shall mean a census tract or census block for the 2020 United States Decennial Census

Section Three.

The City of Bellefontaine Neighbors shall be and is hereby divided into four wards, the boundaries of which are shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit #1 and more fully described in Exhibit #2, both of which are incorporated herein by reference, comprised of the census populations of the 2020 United States Census as listed in Exhibit #3, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section Four.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or parts thereof shall be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they may so conflict; this ordinance superseding same.

Section Five.

Upon passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval of this ordinance by the Mayor, the City Clerk of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors shall certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County, Missouri, for proper processing of same as required by law.

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


