ORDINANCE NO. 2683

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI, REPEALING SECTION (f) OF SECTION 29-126 OF ARTICLE XXII OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS MUNICIPAL CODE AND AMENDING SECTION (g) OF SECTION 29-126 OF ARTICLE XXII OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS MUNICIPAL CODE TO ELIMINATE ANY AND ALL UNCONSTITIONAL "FEES" RELATING TO SAME.

WHEREAS, section 29-126 of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors municipal code deals with "Residential Real Estate" and attempts to create a crime free housing program in the City as to rental properties;

WHEREAS, section 29-126 sections (f) and (g) enacts a "fee tax" which was not voted upon by a majority of voters in the City pursuant to the Hancock Amendment and must be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERPERSON OF THE CITY OF PAGEDALE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Article XXII, Section 29-126 sections (f) and (g) of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors municipal code state as follows:

- (f) Fees and Renewals: The annual fee for each calendar year or portion thereof for the license required by this section shall be three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per owner per each residential dwelling unit in the city due and payable at the time of application. License renewals are due by the end of January of each year. A delinquency fee, calculated at the rate of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each month after January 31 or portion thereof, shall be assessed for late payment of an application fee but may be waived by the director of public works for good cause shown, however, license renewals may not be processed if the property has outstanding violations.
- (g) Occupancy prohibited. Unless and until the annual application is filed by the owner, together with all necessary accompanying documents, and all fees due hereunder are paid in full and all outstanding fines imposed by the Bellefontaine Neighbors Municipal Court for any housing or building code violations by such owner are paid in full, no residential rental license shall be issued to such owner nor shall any new occupancy permit be issued for the occupancy of any parcel of residential rental property of such owner. Failure to obtain and maintain a valid residential rental license shall constitute grounds for the revocation or cancellation of all outstanding occupancy permits issued for any parcels of residential rental property of such owner associated with said rental license. No new occupancy permit shall be required if the occupancy remains the same for any parcel of residential rental property purchased or obtained.

SECTION 2. Article XXII, Section 29-126 section (f) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Article XXII, Section 29-126 section (g) is hereby is hereby amended to read as follows:

(g) Occupancy prohibited. Unless and until the annual application is filed by the owner, together with all necessary accompanying documents, and all outstanding fines imposed by the Bellefontaine Neighbors Municipal Court for any housing or building code violations by such owner are paid in full, no residential rental license shall be issued to such owner nor shall any new occupancy permit be issued for the occupancy of any parcel of residential rental property of such owner. Failure to obtain and maintain a valid residential rental license shall constitute grounds for the revocation or cancellation of all outstanding occupancy permits issued for any parcels of residential rental property of such owner associated with said rental license. No new occupancy permit shall be required if the occupancy remains the same for any parcel of residential rental property purchased or obtained.

SECTION 4. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the Extent of such conflicts hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Alderpersons and Approval by the Mayor.

CERTIFIED COURT MANAGER CONSULTANT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on April _____, 2025, by and between the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Missouri (hereinafter referred to as "Bellefontaine"), and Angela Slay-Chatman Consulting LLC (hereinafter referred to as "Angela Slay-Chatman").

WHEREAS, confirming that a municipal court meets all circuit court and standards set and required by the Missouri Supreme Court requires additional expertise from a subject matter expert who can work with the current Judge and department staff to assist with compliance. Angela Slay-Chatman has unique experience consolidating eight municipal divisions and working with the Office of State Courts Administration (OSCA) on guidelines. She is listed as a subject matter expert with the OSCA.

WHEREAS, Angela Slay-Chatman has expertise (20+ years of professional municipal court administration experience and is a Certified Court Manager-National Center for State Court, Institute for Court Managers, and an Advanced Certified Court Administrator—at the University of Missouri-Columbia) and can assist with all aspects of Court functions and requirements or needed by an agency

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed, consented to, and stipulated by the parties as follows:

- Type of Work: Angela Slay-Chatman will provide services as it relates to operations of Bellefontaine Neighbors Court Department and assist staff with the day-to-day operations of the Court Department, which includes but is not limited to, evaluating and reporting status of court operations, reports, month end close out, working with OSCA to ensure compliance with operations, assisting with court nights and obtaining additional people to assist with operations.
- Pay: In exchange for said services, the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors agrees to pay \$30.00 per hour. It is limited to no more than <u>fifteen</u> hours per week unless approved by the Board of Aldermen or the Mayor due to particular circumstances or a required project.
- 3. Hold Harmless Agreement: Angela Slay-Chatman agrees to hold the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors and any of its agents or employees harmless for all acts, accidents, or occurrences that may occur to any person while Angela Slay-Chatman performs the work under this Agreement.
- 4. Performance Bond: This provision does not apply to this contract or agreement.

SECTION 1: Section 2-102 of Chapter 2, Article III is hereby established and shall read as follows:

Sec. 2-102 - City Clerk, election-duties.

The board of aldermen shall elect a clerk for such board, to be known as "the city clerk", whose duties and term of office shall be fixed by ordinance. Among other things, the city clerk shall keep a journal of the proceedings of the board of aldermen. He shall safely and properly keep all the records and papers belonging to the city which may be entrusted to his care; he shall be the general accountant of the city; he is hereby empowered to administer official oaths and oaths to persons certifying to demands or claims against the city. He shall serve as custodian of records for the City and respond to all Sunshine request as referenced in section 1-30 of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors municipal code and provide monthly reports to the assessor as required by section 2-247 of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors municipal code.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Missouri in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 2682

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI, ESTABLISHING ARTICLE XIII, OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS MUNICIPAL CODE- THE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Missouri is desirous of establishing its "Ways and Means" committee to review City finances and make recommendations regarding same to the Board of Alderpersons.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Article XIII of Chapter 2 of the City of Bellefontaine municipal code is hereby established and enacted creating the "Ways and Means Committee" and shall hereby read as follows:

Sec. 2-307 - Ways and Means Committee

The Ways and Means committee shall have jurisdiction for the purpose of investigation and reporting to the mayor and board of alderpersons all matters pertaining to revenues, public debt, interest, appropriations, disbursements, retrenchment and all other matters not properly referable to other committees. All bills, claims and accounts against the city shall be presented to, and reported on, by this committee. Additionally, the committee shall have accountability and jurisdiction for the purpose of reviewing any and all agreements, contracts and/or financial matters with the city police department and providing recommendations to the mayor and board of alderpersons regarding same.

Sec. 2-308 -Appointment and Composition

The Ways and Means committee shall be appointed by the mayor. The Ways and Means committee shall consist of four (4) members each. The committees shall consist of one (1) alderperson from each ward which shall be appointed by the mayor annually at the first meeting after the city election in April or as soon thereafter as practical and the person named first on the committee shall be chairperson thereof. Additionally, at the first meeting after the city election in April, or as soon thereafter as practical, a vice-chairperson of the committee shall be named by a majority vote of the committee to serve in the event that the chairperson cannot attend a committee meeting. In the event a vice-chairperson serves in the absence of the chairperson, the vice-chairperson shall have the same powers as the chairperson. Committee members appointed by the Mayor shall serve a term of (3) years and may be re-appointed. Members shall serve until a successor is selected and qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for the balance of the unexpired term.

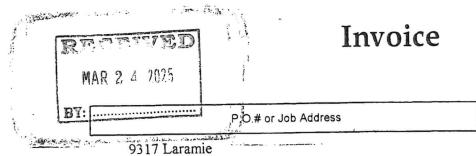

April Report 2025

We held our Annual Easter Egg Hunt on April 12 @ Bissell Hills Park to delight of 74 youth and adults. Our families enjoyed free books, ice cream and Easter egg hunting. We will be looking to bring the Easter Egg Hunt back to the Rec. Center grounds in 2026.

We held 2 parent meeting in April for the Redbird Rookies baseball program. We are up to 75 youth with registration closing May 2. Coaches are still needed for the program and we anticipate starting mid-June.

Our Municipal Parks are now open for rental as of April 21. We ask that everyone is aware that park season brings about a lot of unscheduled activities at the pavilions and vandalism. We ask that unusual activity be reported, all reserved pavilions are marked with signage.

We hosted our first ever Senior Prom titled A Night in Paris. The prom was organized to give our older adults an opportunity to provide a fun and memorable evening for older adults, allowing them to socialize, dance, and relive experiences. The event included catered food from Hendel's Restaurant, a professional photographer, DJ services from The Smooth Crew and poetry by Free Will. Essence Health Care provided \$500 to cover the food for the event and Oak St. Health was on hand with health information. Our older adults had a nice time and all the feedback was very positive.

Grace Shortall has been hired as our new Recreation Specialists, replacing the vacant position left by Ashley Stenson. Grace has been associated with the Recreation Center since childhood. She learned to swim here, became a member of the swim team and currently coaches the swim team and works part-time in our front office. Grace will join staff on June 2 in her new position.

We welcomed our first intern from Job Corps Job Placement program. The program provides young adults 19-24 with valuable work experience while they pursue certifications in their fields of study. Our intern is currently assisting with janitorial and park duties with our staff Monday- Thursday from 9am-2pm. This is an unpaid internship.
