MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CLOSED
BOARD OF ALDERMEN MEETING

Tuesday June 24, 2025 7:30 p.m.

The Board of Aldermen met for a special closed meeting on Tuesday, June 24, 2025 immediately after the budget public hearing.

Mayor Thomas presided over the meeting. He called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Roll Call
