

The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, June 19, 2018 at Bellefontaine Neighbors Recreation Center.

Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:01 p.m.

The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 were accepted as presented. Mark mentioned losing a Bus Driver. He had to go out of town due to health issues in his family and called to say he won't be coming back. A discussion followed.

Mark turned the meeting over to Jay and Kay with SWT and they went over the final plan and the drawings for the final plan for Bissell Hills Park as well as more information for the Companies making bids and comparing prices to make the best choice. A discussion followed concerning the plans for the park as well as whether they will be tapping into the existing utilities and whether the parking will be remaining the same. We'll be keeping the existing sign but making some repairs to it. A discussion followed concerning the Walking Trail as well as the Restrooms and Pavilion staying where they are. A discussion followed concerning storage space and delivery and installation of the Pavilion and Restrooms. Mark asked if there is anything in the plans for lighting and mentioned we need three light poles and we may be installing a camera in one of the lights so we can monitor the activity from here. Mark said I spoke with Ameren and told them I wanted the light poles taken out. Jay asked if anyone had any questions and a discussion followed concerning the Walking Trail. It was mentioned to remove the steps by the Church. A discussion followed concerning having decorative plants by the Park Sign. Jay mentioned getting the package ready by July and bids out no later than August and begin the construction in the Fall. A discussion followed including money for benches and trash receptacles. Mark mentioned the existing structure was torn down by City employees. Mark asked about the design for the sign and a discussion followed on the original Bissell Hills park sign as well as putting in a BBQ pit on an extra pad to keep the smoke away from the pavilion.

Kathy Endorf reported we had 13 kids at the last fishing class. I had my husband come to help so if anyone else would like to help the next class is scheduled for Thursday, July 12th at 5:30 p.m. Kathy also mentioned we need more water and snacks for the participants. Dave Cross mentioned a woman showed up with two little kids. They were okay but they had to be watched. A discussion followed including having Wayne come in and work on the fishing gear as well as Dave getting hooked by one of the kids.

The Park Board Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
