

The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, August 18, 2015 at Bellefontaine Neighbors Recreation Center.

Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:03 p.m.

Present: Kathy Endorf, Tina Swindle, Judy Mantych and Mark Dickerson; Director of Parks and Recreation.

Absent: Sally Wahlbrink, Jane Davis, Dave Cross and Alderman Don Merz.

Mark Dickerson informed the Park Board members Jean Garascia called and resigned from the Park Board due to health issues. She has been a member of the Park Board since 1979. We thank Jean for her service and dedication to the Park Board and wish her the best with her health issues.

Mark Dickerson reported we were supposed to get the Park Assessment Recommendations in time for our August meeting but have not received it yet. I should have it by our September meeting. Mark said he'd hoped to have more public interest from the second open house. A discussion followed concerning the lack of interest and participation. Mark mentioned they will be starting the grants up again for next year. I won't be putting in for a grant to do something physically. If the assessment comes in we'll have a couple meetings to possibly decide on one park to start with. Then I'll put in for another grant and if we get that we'll have \$8,000.00 to do a plan for a park. Depending on what the plan is and if there are working drawings or we could purchase a pre-made gazebo so we wouldn't need drawings since it would come with instructions. Then the following year we could put in to have a park done or spend some money. Mark said he'll do the grant meeting again next year.

Mark reported the brochure went out last weekend. I will also start draining the indoor pool before I leave tonight. I got bids to put a new deck on the indoor pool area. The last time it was done was in 1999 and it needs some attention. We will also be painting the gutters. We'll probably re-open the indoor pool the day after Labor Day. Mark also mentioned the Fall session of classes will also begin the day after Labor Day.

Mark reported the Beer & Wine Party is scheduled for October 10th. A discussion followed.

Mark reported we are taking bids for a new camera system for the Recreation Center. We'll be doing it in house. When asked if there is a camera for the parking lot Mark reported City Hall has one and we will be putting up another one.

Mark was asked what happened to the television in the Lobby and reported it went out and we are working on getting a part to fix it. A discussion followed.

Kathy Endorf asked if they caught the person who stole the car off the parking lot and Mark said yes, we won't be seeing him again.

Mark mentioned Bob Doerr announced at the last Board of Alderman Meeting that Kroger's is trying to buy the whole Bissell Hills Shopping Center. Mark said Shop n Save and a furniture store wanted to go in but the current owner wanted the companies to make the necessary improvements to bring everything up to code and pay rent. So now he finally wants to sell it. If Kroger's gets it they will be putting in a Rulers Grocery Store which will be similar to Aldi's and will fix up and fill the other stores. They will be taking over everything

stopping at US Bank. A discussion followed concerning all the different stores that have been in the shopping center in the past, as well as what won't be allowed.

The Park Board Meeting adjourned at 7:41 p.m.
