Discussion about clean up of the neighborhood streets. Discussion about possible community service in lieu of court fines as a way to clean up trash on our streets. Need to check on liability issues. Is it possible for this to be put into place within the city of Bellefontaine Neighbors?

Discussion about crosswalks that need to be painted by the city. These include: Ashbrook & Cabot (Holy Name of Jesus Church), Ashbrook & Kilgore (Bellefontaine Baptist Church), Cabot & Coburg Lands (4-way stop), Kilgore & Lance (Grace Lutheran Church), Fonda & Delhi (Gibson School), St. Cyr & Adler (Danforth School), St. Cyr & Yorktown (Danforth School), 10200 Block of Ashbrook (Bissell Hills Park).

The city would only responsible for crosswalks that cross city streets. Crosswalks that cross county roads (Chambers Rd. & St. Cyr Rd.) are St. Louis County's responsibility.

Thank you to the street department for snow removal during the last storm.

Discussion about Waste Management and their need to clean up if a truck or driver causes a mess with trash. Contact City Hall if you have an issue with Waste Management. Leaves and yard waste cannot be placed in plastic bags. Use the correct canisters for trash, yard waste and recyclables.
