Old Business

Open actions items: Planting four boxwoods in front of Tanglewood Park sign, planting two boxwoods on the corner of Jennings Station Road and at sign on Bellefontaine Road and replacing rotten wooden ties with brick at Bellefontaine sign on Lilac. Jennie asked the committee if they wanted to duplicate what was done at Jennings Station and 367 and plant mums and butterfly bushes instead of the boxwoods and bricks at Bellefontaine Rd and Raford.

Jennie asked if we wanted to bring some of our litter bags and distribute to adults with cars.
