METRO St Louis Adopt-A-Stop

Jennie received a copy of the Adopt-A-Stop Agreement, a list of bus stops in Bellefontaine and Safety Guidelines from Maureen Williams at Metro. The list of bus stop will be divided amongst the Board members. Each Board member will visit their designated stops to see if there is a lot of litter and recommend whether the Board should adopt the stop.

With Bob Bost's approval, the Board agreed to adopt a stop "In Memory of Jeannette Bost". It was also agreed that all other stops that will be adopted by a Board member will also include the following wording "Bellefontaine Image and Beautification Board".

New Initiative

Handing out Image and Beautification Flyers in Board Members Neighborhoods— Leo Gordon agreed to speak at the April 20th Aldermen Meeting and share the idea of a placing I/B Flyer on our neighbors door. Leo will also ask the Aldermen/Alderwomen to partner with the Board member and help hand out the flyer. If a neighbor is visible, it will be a good way to for the Aldermen to connect with the citizens. It will also allow the Board member to inform the neighbor about the actions of the Board and invite them to volunteer to serve. Board members will contact their Aldermen to set up a date and time to hand out the flyer.
