A discussion followed on the equipment and the Bellefontaine Park Pond. Mark mentioned our Department is very interested in the program but needs to look into the liability of the City's involvement. A discussion followed.

Mark reported the Mayor's Golf Tournament is scheduled for April 21, 2018. If anyone is available to help it would be greatly appreciated.

Kathy Endorf reported the Racquetball Court is dirty and needs to be mopped. Kathy asked if anyone had heard of Pickle Ball. Mark said yes. A discussion was held concerning the game. Kathy asked if we could paint a line on the gym floor for Pickle Ball. Mark said I think we can use tape instead of paint. I will look into it. Mark mentioned a Pickle Ball Court is 20' x 44'.

Mark reported the City has been looking for a part time bus driver and might have one on board. Tina Swindle mentioned her brother drives for St. Ann. Mark asked if he would be interested in working part time for us and Tina said she will ask him.
