The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at Bellefontaine Neighbors Recreation Center.

Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:01 p.m.

Present: Tina Fichter, Kathy Endorf, Judy Mantych, Dave Cross and Mark Dickerson; Director of Parks & Recreation Absent: Alderman Don Merz

The Minutes for the November Park Board Meeting were accepted as presented.

A discussion followed concerning changing the fees charged for Basketball. An adult or child resident would pay \$1.00 per visit or \$30.00 per year for basketball. With the weight room pass or swim pass there would be no user fee for the gymnasium. Non-residents currently pay \$5.00 per visit. All non-residents will need to get an I.D. Card for \$6.00 and it will cost \$6.00 per visit any time they play basketball. If there is a problem with a non-resident user they will no longer be permitted to enter the Recreation Center. Recreation Center daily fees will stay the same. Pool fees will go up \$1.00 to \$4.00 for a dult residents and \$3.00 for child residents. The non-resident fee will be \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for a child. A discussion followed. The fee for Room Reservations will also be raised. The reservation fee for Room #109 will be \$70.00 for the rental with a \$50.00 deposit fee and Room #101 will be 80.00 for the rental and \$50.00 for the deposit. All Park Shelter fees will go up to \$45.00 for residents for any of the parks and \$75.00 for non-residents to reserve Tanglewood Park. Swim Lessons are 20.00 per 6 week session for residents and will go up to \$24.00. The non-resident fee for swim lessons will be raised from \$26.00 to \$30.00 for the six week session. The fee for Gym Classes will remain the same. There is no fee for the use of the Senior Bus. We could consider starting to charge a fee. We still get some donations but not as many as we got in the past.

Mark mentioned a price was given by the Mayor and Staff to Trinity High School for a Lock-In on May 17, 2019. The cost is approximately \$1,000.00 for the event for 82 students. A discussion followed.

Mark mentioned the Golf Tournament is on April 13th and I can use the help so mark your calendars.

Mark passed out pictures of the Restrooms for Bissell Hills Park and reported they will be pouring the footings Friday for the Shelter. The Shelter should be done by the end of the month. We'll be getting a new parking lot, sidewalk and the sign will be redone. We will be able to put cameras on the shelter. I think it will look nice and they hope to be done in March or by May at the latest. Parking will be the same. Hopefully I'll know more by the February meeting. A discussion followed.

Mark asked if anyone had anything and Kathy Endorf said some of the lights need to be replaced in the gym. Mark mentioned some of the lights are out in the pool also.

Mark said we finally have a bus driver but he doesn't have his CDL so he has to drive the small bus. A discussion followed. Kathy mentioned her neighbor uses the bus and loves it. Mark mentioned Amy uses the bus to take people on trips.

Mark said hopefully by the next meeting we'll have a lot more done at the park. Meeting Adjourned 7:44 pm.
