Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:01 p.m.

Mark asked if everyone received their Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, January 15, 2019 and a discussion followed.

A discussion followed concerning Recreation Center fee changes. Mark mentioned next month we'll start working on the Summer Brochure so I'll know the fee changes before then. A discussion followed concerning the charges for Pickleball. Mark said he'll meet with Amy and make sure it's clear. Mark reported when we start on the Summer Brochure the new fees will go into effect approximately June 1<sup>st</sup> so the residents will get a warning of the fee increases. A discussion followed.

The Mayor's Golf Tournament is scheduled for April 13<sup>th</sup>. I've sent out letters for Hole Sponsors and will send out the information and registration sheets to participants at the end of the week so they'll have five weeks to plan ahead.

A discussion followed on the Restrooms being finished at Bissell Hills Park. Mark reported the water and sewer lines are in. The electric is in but not engaged. The footings are in for the Shelter. The Shelter was being made but not finished or shipped as of two weeks ago. With the weather they wouldn't have been able to put it in. They're working on the parking area. It's supposed to be nice later in the week so they'll get a lot done by the end of the week. They'll do the sidewalk once the concrete sets up. A discussion followed. Wagner has sent prints of the sign and will tuck point the housing that holds the sign. Once the weather is good it won't take long at all. The Company that built the shelter will come here and install the shelter within a couple of days. They'll clean up and by March or April they'll put in the plants. An Alderwoman asked if we're having a Grand Opening, a Ribbon Cutting or a plaque. Mark stated I imagine a good time to do that would be the end of April or beginning of May. I'll discuss it with the Mayor and a discussion followed.

Mark reported the new bus driver is doing well but hasn't gotten his CDL yet. Hopefully he'll get it by Spring.

Mark mentioned a problem at City Hall and the Recreation Center with heating and cooling. It started acting up last week and they were out yesterday and they got things going. Hopefully we'll have it up and running by summer and more control than last week.

Amy is working on the Summer Brochure and as soon as this month is over if I don't hear anything from the Aldermen I'll be changing the fees. We're not trying to gouge anyone I'm just bumping everything up a little and it will help our bottom line. A discussion followed concerning the raising of the minimum wage to \$12.00. A discussion followed.

Mark mentioned Amy asked if anyone can help with the St. Patrick Dinner and Mark asked if Dave Cross will be able to BBQ on the 13<sup>th</sup> that would be good. A discussion followed.

Mark mentioned ordering trees for the Easter Egg Hunt/Arbor Day Event. They are out of Red Bud and Dogwood trees. A discussion followed.

Mark said he doesn't have anything else and asked if anyone else had anything else. Kathy Endorf mentioned the lights are still out in the gym? Mark mentioned she should ask the office staff to turn up the lights. A discussion followed.

The Park Board Meeting adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
