Old Business:

<u>Adopt A Street Program</u>

Beautification Action Day – April 27, 2019

Jeannie asked Board members to report on the organizations they contacted regarding volunteering at the Beautification Action Day. Caroline she was unsuccessful in her attempts to reach someone at the Matthews-Dickey Boys and Girls Club, but did talk to the Director of Communications at Riverview School District about participating. Flyers were circulated and we are expecting a count from Riverview Gardens. Leo contacted Curtis from the Masonic Order. He said he would take the request back to the Lodge in Jennings, but didn't think they would make the April cleanup. Jennie and Leo talked to LaTanja and she said she would get back with the number of volunteers participating. Jim volunteered to contact the Fire Department regarding participating in our cleanups. Shelley said she reached out to the Riverview Fire District. She said the Fire District has a cleanup scheduled in May.
