# Public Safety Commission Meeting

Meeting Called to Order at 6:30 p.m.

**Police Report:** Chief Ihler said there were no reports of serious damage from the storms which moved through the area. He has included \$10,000 for portable traffic speed monitors in the proposed budget. In other budget proposals, the Police Department wished to replace four patrol cars which are past their four-year replacement date.

Fire Department Report: There was no report from the Riverview Fire Department.

#### **New Business:**

Alderwoman Tatman reported on several upcoming Community events which may be taking place over the summer: The Bellefontaine Family Fest is scheduled for July 13<sup>th</sup> at the Rec Center; the Riverview School District will hold a Back to School event the first week of August; and there is a renewed discussion of preparing a Public Safety Strategic Plan. A question was raised - does the Rec Center have a back- up power supply? If yes, it could be used as an emergency shelter.

Sandra Henry had several questions and comments to the Police Department and this committee. She commended the police for their response to a traffic accident. She asked more detailed questions about the Police Department budget.
