BACKGROUND:

Begin management of the city-owned tree population. While a tree inventory typically comes first, The City has an obligation to its citizens to mitigate risk prior to long-term planning critical risk trees located on city property. These trees were identified by an ISA Certified Arborist on March 24, 2021 with Street Department Director Jeff Ross (Street Department Supervisor), and Jimmy Kirincich (Director of Parks and Recreation) also in attendance. Bellefontaine Neighbors next steps are after completion of this project are tree inventory, working towards becoming a Tree City USA, and assessing the need for the next generation of trees in Bellefontaine Neighbors.

The City of Bellefontaine Neighbors (hereinafter "the City") is soliciting proposals for removal, trimming, grinding stumps to below grade, leveling area and removing excess chips.

All contractors are expected to perform housekeeping on a daily basis or more often if the nature of work requires <u>it</u>. The City's grounds & facilities shall remain free of construction debris & waste except when transporting same to the removal containers. Any debris/waste dropped along the way must be picked up & removed by the Contractor immediately.

Every effort should be made to minimize the damage to the Park grounds during the tree removal process.

Safety glasses, safety shoes and other OSHA-required personal protective equipment (PPE) shall be used at all times.

The parks and surrounding area is occupied and reasonable accommodations must be made for the City's activities within it. The job site locations are adjacent to residential buildings. Unless otherwise approved by the City, starting time shall be 7:30 AM.

All contractors are advised that, while reasonable efforts will be made by the City to consolidate the work to minimize the number of mobilizations required, it is understood the work may require multiple trips.

Timing:

- Proposals should be submitted no later than Noon on Monday, September 13, 2021. The bid opening meeting will take place on September 13, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. at City Hall Council Chambers located at 9641 Bellefontaine Rd, St. Louis, MO 63137.
- It is expected that approval will come in September 2021 and a purchase order for the work will be issued shortly thereafter.
- All work, invoices, and supporting documents must be completed between November 1, 2021-March 31, 2022.

SCOPE OF WORK:

Contractors will be responsible for all on-site management, labor, materials, equipment, supplies & lawful disposal needed to perform the following work, some of which is not shown or described in detail:

Tree Locations: All trees are marked with an orange X at each location for easy identification

- 1. Oak (2 DEAD TOTAL) Remove to ground level, grind stump to below grade, level area and remove excess chips. Trees are located at Tanglewood Park at end of parking lot. (1180 Chambers Rd, St. Louis, MO 63137)
- 2. Oak (3 Total) Remove to ground level, grind stump to below grade, level area and remove excess chips. Trees are located Bissell Hills Park. (10237 Ashbrook, St. Louis, MO 63137)
- 3. Pin Oak (1 Dead Total) Remove to ground level, grind stump to below grade, level area and remove excess chips. Tree is located at Bel Grove Park. (1246 Bel Grove Dr, Saint Louis, MO 63137)
- Ash (1 Dead Total) & Austrian Pine (1 Dead Total) Remove to ground level, grind stump to below grade, level area and remove excess chips. Trees are located at Allen S. Pruett Park. (1167 Foxlair Dr., St. Louis, MO 63137)
- 5. Oak (1 Total) Prune deadwood 2" and greater, clean cut stubs and broken limbs, clear houses 10-12' and elevate 20-25' from ground. Tree is located at 1110 Duneke, St. Louis, MO 63137.
- 6. Oak (1 total) Remove to ground level, grind stump to below grade, level area and remove excess chips. Tree is showing signs of hypoxylon canker. Tree is located at 1143 Siebe, St. Louis, MO 63137.
- 7. Oak (1 total) Remove to ground level, grind stump to below grade, level area and remove excess chips. Tree is located behind tennis courts at St. Cyr Park. 1037 Hopedale, St. Louis, MO 63137.

Contractor Inclusions

- Insurance: Name the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors Missouri as "additional insured" on Contractor's insurance certificate for the duration of this work after authorization to proceed.
- 2. Contractor shall include a **Contract Bond** to guarantee fulfillment and performance of all work promised in the contract.
- 3. Barricading to keep bystanders out of harm's way.
- 4. All labor, expertise, materials and equipment needed for safe removal of trees.
- 5. Contractor shall haul away & dispose of all crating, dunnage and debris.
- 6. Provide lien waivers at time of billing. Copies of material, labor & equipment tickets for all work to repair all outof-scope, concealed damage shall be submitted with billing.
- 7. There may be homeowners or public near the parks. Coordination, communication and working harmoniously with others shall be considered **essential requirements** for this work.

Contractor Exclusions

8. Other services, materials or equipment not associated with the core work previously described.

CITY COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS:

The City seeks to ensure that the highest quality workmanship will be performed on its projects and to do so, encourages bidders to use employees on the projects who have satisfactorily completed apprenticeship programs developed and operated in accordance with the policy recommendation, dated January 28, 1992, of the Federal Committee on apprenticeship, U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Office of Workbased Learning, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training (the "policy recommendation"). All bidders are required to certify in their bids the percentage of their prospective employees for the project which have satisfactorily completed such a program for the type of work they will be performing.

It is the policy of the City that it will affirmatively encourage minority business enterprise and women's business enterprise participation in contracts and programs which it administers with the objective of increasing the participation by businesses owned or controlled by minorities and women and the City will assure that all reasonable efforts are made within the confines of the law which will aid in meeting this objective.
