Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at Bellefontaine Neighbors Recreation Center.

Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:33 p.m.

The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on November 19, 2012 were accepted as presented.

A discussion was held concerning the sign at Klein Park. Topics included the timing of the messages as well as how many messages could be presented which is 12 to 15. The Board members suggested posting the dates for the Board of Alderman Meetings as well as the Neighborhood Watch Meetings. It was also suggested if Neighborhood Watch changed their name they might get more city involvement.

Mark said it is also harder to clean. Tiles were also mentioned and Mark said he would have to shave the concrete floor if he went with tile so they would lay flat. A discussion followed. Mark said whatever we go with it needs to be a darker color but not too dark. Tina Swindle suggested painting the walls and re-staining the wood. Mark said we will probably get the carpet in the spring.

Alease Dailes mentioned having a problem with a water leak. A discussion was held on how the Water Company prioritizes the repairs.

Jane Davis mentioned it would be nice to have someplace to hang coats in the weight room. A discussion followed.

A discussion was held concerning the Welcome Sign at 270 and Bellefontaine Road working again.

The Park Board Meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
