The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, August 20, 2013 were accepted as presented.

Mark mentioned he hasn't heard from Riverview yet on when they will set up the meeting with Gateway Green. I'll let you know when I hear from them.

The Beer/Wine Event is scheduled for Saturday, October 12<sup>th</sup>. If anyone would like to help out let me know. Tina Swindle said she can be here. Mark asked if the Board would like to do the music for the event in house instead of paying someone. A discussion followed concerning seeing if Craig can put something together on the computer. Mark said if I use Anthony, I'd need to know if I'd have a good crowd to cover the cost. A discussion followed. Jean Garascia asked when Mark wanted the workers to arrive and Mark said 4:00 or 4:30. The event will run from 5:30 to 9:30 p.m. Mark mentioned the City Picnic is scheduled for Saturday, October 12<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. There will also be a metro area church group who helped out at seven or eight houses after the tornado who will be cleaning vines off the fence near the creek in Bissell at Coburg Lands and Ashbrook. They wanted to do service hours. A discussion followed.

Mark reported the Beautification Day is scheduled for Saturday, September 28<sup>th</sup>.
